

BCD-3 CD Player

Remote Control Options

Dryston's new BCD-3 dedicated CD player can be remotely controlled in a number of ways. Traditional IR remote control such as universal models or Bryston's own BR-2 work. System automators can use RS232 or an IP command set. You can also use a smart device and access the web-based graphical user interface.

Use Bryston's optional multiproduct all-aluminum motion sensitive backlit BR-2 remote control. Press the CD button to access features.



Program a 3rd party universal remote control such as a Logitech Harmony to control the BCD-3. Contact Bryston for codes or use the BCD-1 code set provided by your universal remote control manufacturer.



Connect your BCD-3 to your home network. Press the Stop button two times to reveal the IP address on the display. Enter that address in your web browser on your tablet or smart phone to connect to the webbased graphical user interface to control your BCD-3.
